EXTENSION OF SUB-BRANCH RECEIPT DEADLINE FOR CONGRESS 2018 MOTIONS

The Constitution states that State Council must give 8 weeks' notice to sub-branches for the receipt of motions to be included in the agenda for Annual State Congress. In July 2017 circular 28/17 nominated 26 February as the closing date for motions based on the premise that State Council would meet on the last Friday of February as has been normal practice.

In 2018 State Council meet on March 7 and 8, not late February. This later than normal date was set to allow for appropriate consideration of the Bergin Inquiry report and member feedback on the strategic directions paper.

State Council met on 21 February and resolved to extend the time for receipt of motions for Congress to until midnight 7 March 2018.

Sub-Branches and District Councils are directed to have all motions for Annual State Congress 2018 submitted for consideration by the Agenda Committee before midnight on 7 March 2018.
